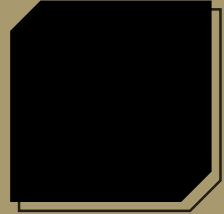

Three signature scholarships — the Ingram Scholars Program, the Cornelius Vanderbilt Scholarship, and the Chancellor's Scholarship — comprise the majority of Vanderbilt's merit-based awards.

Recipients of these scholarships are guaranteed full-tuition awards for up to eight semesters that include a stipend for research, study abroad, a creative endeavor, or the required Immersion Vanderbilt experience.

No, the application for need-based scholarships is separate from the merit-based scholarship application process. To be considered for merit-based scholarships, there is a separate application process via your MyAppVU portal after you apply for admission. Vanderbilt students have been very successful in obtaining outside sources of assistance. For example, during the 2018–2019 academic year, Vanderbilt undergraduates were awarded outside assistance of more than \$6,560,471.
